Dear Parents and Cast Members:

We are about to begin work on an exciting theatre project which will require a great commitment from both the cast members and their families. Theatre demands an incredible combination of child-like playfulness and military-like discipline, therefore, we would like to clearly outline rehearsal requirements before we start.

Each cast member called to rehearsal is vitally important to the group as a whole. Therefore, for the sake of the cast, two unexcused absences may result in reduction of role or dismissal. If you discover that you have any conflicts that are not on your audition form, please let your Director or Producer know immediately. We realize that things do come up suddenly at times, so if you discover that you will need to miss a rehearsal, tell the Director as far in advance as possible, in writing. Except in the event of illness, the Director must be warned of an absence in advance in order to excuse a cast member.
