## Election Day is Nov 6: Get Out and Vote!

Election day is November 6. Ballots should be arriving in your mailbox this week. Please take the time to review the election guide, do your own research, be informed, be rational, understand the issues and vote. There are three major education issues to consider in this election.

- Washington Supreme Court in the McCleary decision ordered the Legislature to fully fund education. Different candidates have different ideas how this can be accomplished so consider this task as you research the candidates and decide your votes.
- Initiative 1240 Charter Schools: Bringing Charter Schools to Washington is a very complicated and emotional issue which even the PTA is torn on.
